

TRC lands RM950m LRT extension job

KUALA LUMPUR: TRC Synergy Bhd has secured the largest package of the first phase of the Kelana Jaya Light Rail Transit (LRT) extension project, worth RM950 million.

Yesterday, the company announced that its construction arm, Trans Resources Sdn Bhd, had received the letter of acceptance from Syarikat Prasarana Negara Bhd to be the main contractor for the line extension job.

The LRT project secured consists of a 9.2km extension from Kelana Jaya station to Summit Shopping Centre in Subang Jaya, which is to be completed within 30 months.

Zin said the LRT extension project boosts TRC's book order to RM1.2 billion. "Leveraging on our government's commitment to execute initiatives under the Economic Transformation Programme, we are confident of our prospects in securing more orders in the near future."

Over the last three years, TRC had successfully completed several major projects, notably the submarine base at Sepangar Bay (RM421 million), the runway extension (packages 3 and 4) at Terengganu airport (RM401 million) and the police headquarters at Dang Wangi, Kuala Lumpur (RM125 million).
