TRC bags RM45m job from Boustead

KUALA LUMPUR: TRC Synergy Bhd's construction arm Trans Resources Corp. Sdn Bhd has secured a RM45 million contract from Boustead Penang Shipyard Sdn Bhd to build submarine safety conditioning and workshop facilities, and a submarine hangar, in Sepangar Bay, Sabah.

The 27-month job is in relation to an earlier Royal Malaysian Navy contract to provide in-service support for two units of Scorpene class submarines.

TRC executive chairman Datuk Seri
Sufri Mohd Zin said the latest contract
followed a RM404 million contract to build
a new naval base in Sepangar Bay in 2000.

"Previously, in the course of the construction, we worked very closely with global experts in submarine base construction and adhered to global best practices as it was a highly challenging and critical project," he said. The experience has placed TRC as a leading contractor in Malaysia, he added in a statement.
